October 10th, 2018

District report: Dr. Steve Katz reported that the AAE continues with the consumer engagement initiative, which promotes endodontists to the public. That will be fully implemented in January 2019. The AAE is moving headquarters within the next six months from the ADA building and into an office near Millenium Park in the financial district.
