Lecture Topic: An Update on Pain, Purulence and Pandemics

Lecture Synopsis:

Managing dental pain in emergency patients is a critical element of endodontic care. Recognizing risk factors and pharmacologic drug reactions must be completed before providing analgesics to dental patients. This presentation will describe the principles of managing a dental infection with non-pharmacological treatment and antibiotics as well as describe how to provide dental care in the era of COVID-19.

Learning Objectives:

1. Describe a fast and efficient routine for managing dental pain emergency patients
2. Select the best combination of analgesics to manage dental pain
3. Describe risk factors for opioid use disorder

4. Describe a practical method that combines non-pharmacological treatment with the appropriate antibiotics for managing dental infections.
5. Understand the growing recognition of bacterial strains resistant to current antibiotics and be able to describe how to manage this problem.
6. Describe clinical outcome studies comparing one appointment to multiple appointment procedure
7. Describe changes in equipment and policies in the dental practice designed to mitigate the risk of exposure and spread of SARS-CoV-2.
8. Describe communication strategies with dental patients to manage symptomatic patients and to reassure them for receiving dental care in the era of COVID-19.
9. Described changes in emergency appointment care, regularly scheduled care and dealing with COVID concerns about providers, staff and patients.

PROFESSIONAL BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Hargreaves is currently professor and chair of the department of endodontics, and professor in the departments of pharmacology, physiology and surgery at the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio.

He received his D.D.S. degree from Georgetown University School of Dentistry, Ph.D. in physiology from the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, Md., and Certificate in Endodontics from the University of Minnesota, where he served as an associate professor of endodontics and pharmacology for seven years, and maintained a private practice limited to endodontics. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics.

He was a senior staff fellow at the Pain Clinic of the Neurobiology and Anesthesiology Branch of the National Institute of Dental and Craniofacial Research/National Institutes of Health for five years, and later served as associate professor of endodontics and pharmacology at the University of Minnesota for seven years. In 1997, he joined the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio as professor and chair of the department of endodontics with a joint position in the departments of pharmacology, physiology and surgery.

His area of research focuses on the pharmacology of pain and inflammation. He has received the National Institutes of Health MERIT Award for pain research, two International Association for Dental Research Distinguished Scientist Awards, and the ADA Gold Medal Award for Research. He has

published more than 200 articles. He co-edited *Seltzer and Bender's Dental Pulp* with Drs. Harold E. Goodis and Frank Tay, and the 11th edition of *Cohen's Pathways of the Pulp* with Drs. Louis Berman.
